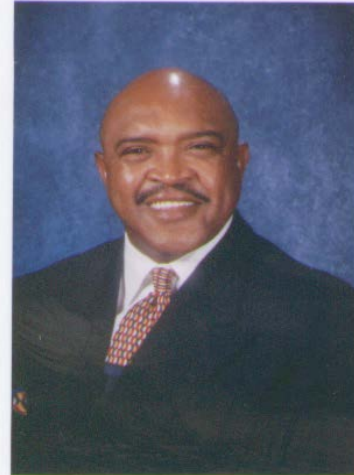

Pee Wee's officiating career began at William Jewell College in 1965 where as the first African American to attend and graduate, he gained honors as All American Honorable Mention in Basketball and All American Honors in track as the 1964 NAIA National High Champ. While earning his Master's Degree at Kansas University he was recruited to start working collegiate sports. His major accomplishment for he would like to be remembered is helping others enter the officiating ranks and seeing them advance.

Pee Wee was the Supervisor of Officials for Heart of America Football and Women's Basketball.

He officiated Baseball Championships in Missouri Valley, MIAA, Heart of America, NAIA, and 2 NCAA Regional Championships.

In Basketball he officiated in the tournaments of every league mentioned above plus the NIT, Pan American Games, World Games, Olympic Festival, International Games in Brazil, and Antigua.
